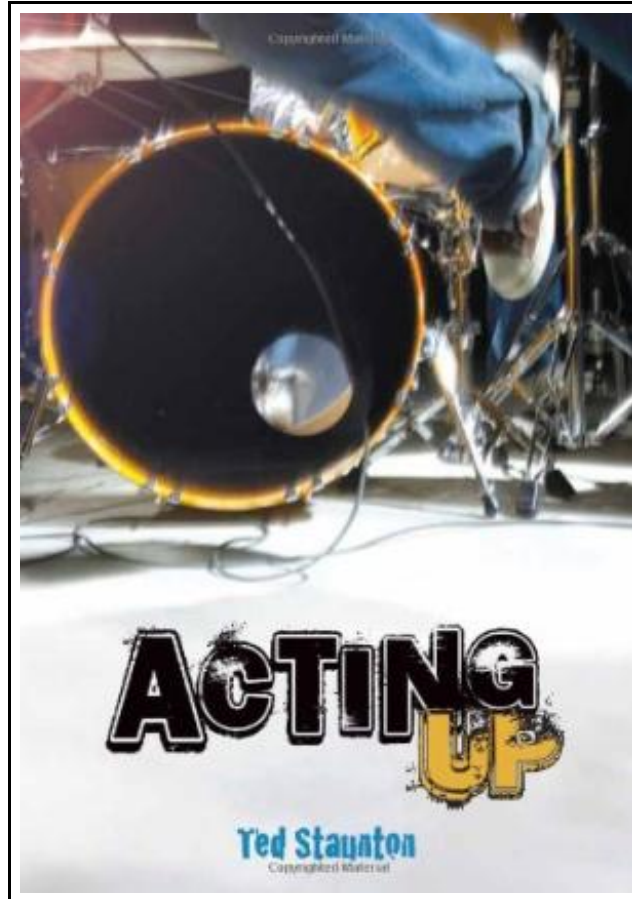

He has absorbed some of the rules for achieving maturity, though he has not yet reached that pinnacle.
