

The latter is the proper pursuit of Europe, in the nineteenth century; but Nature, regardless of the condition of human society, produces the marvellous; and the million yielding to her impressions, the result appears in the brilliant career of such a man as Lord Byron. That Byron eclipsed every poet of his time cannot be questioned; but, as this is a scribbling age, and the suitors of Fame are...
