Each plate has on the inside 3 beds for the shot, of a depth equal to half the thickness of the plate. They are made in the form of a spherical segment, the curvature of which is the same as that of the shot; their centers are on equidistant radii, midway between the edge of the bolthole and that of the plate. In the upper plate are 2 holes. 25 inch diameter placed opposite to each other at. 5 inch from the edge of the plate to receive a rope handle. For the 8-inch siege-howitzer the stand of grape must be attached to a sabot as for canisters. The sabot may be fastened to the lower plate with screws, or the bolt may...
